

TSCA Declaration

Toxic Substances Control Act of 1976 (TSCA)

As required under TSCA, as amended by the Frank R. Lautenberg Chemical Safety for the 21st Century Act, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued five final rules on 6th January 2021, to reduce exposures to certain chemicals that are persistent, bio accumulative and toxic (PBT) under TSCA Section 6(h).

Bulgin Limited (including the Arcolectric brand), as a manufacturer of articles, is reliant on our supply chain to ensure that the substances/articles we use comply with Section 6(h) of TSCA. However, we do not routinely analyse their products for the above substances.

Based on our knowledge at this point in time, our articles are compliant with the cited legislation and do not knowingly contain any of the five regulated PBT chemicals:

- 1. Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1))
- 2. Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE)
- 3. 2,4,6-tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6 TTBP)
- 4. Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD)
- 5. Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)

If this situation changes we confirm that this information will be passed through the supply chain in a timely manner.
